Laura Kordick-Myers PT, DPT, CIMT, CIDN

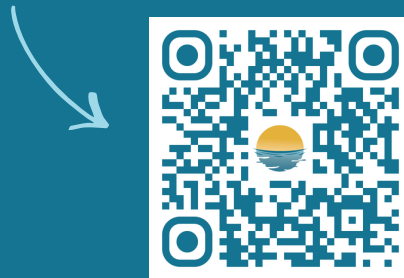

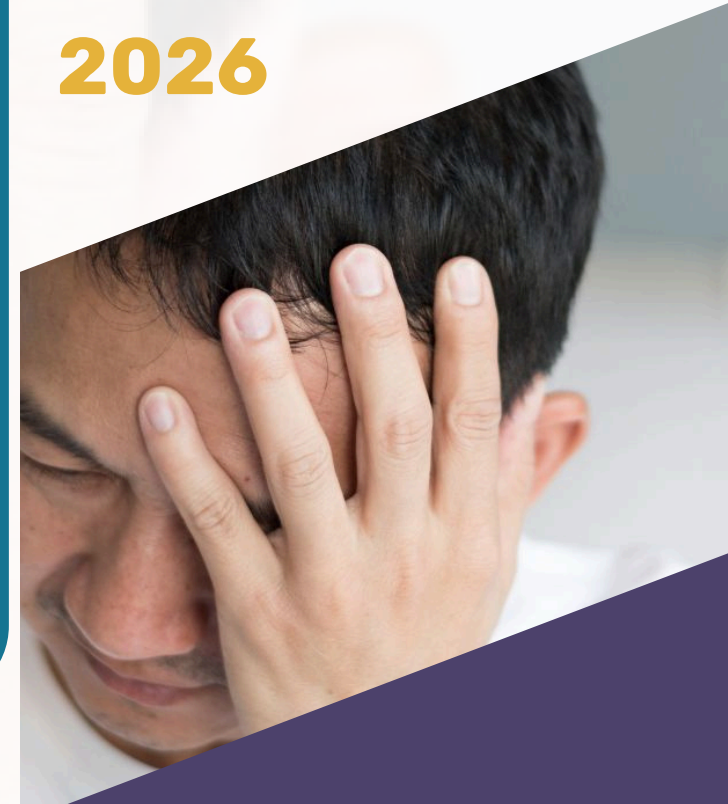

Evaluation and Treatment of Concussions

Course Description
