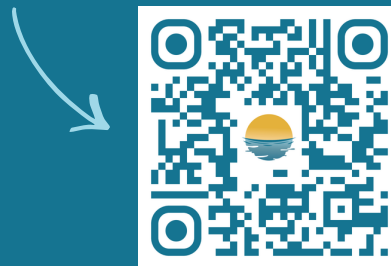

A Manual Therapy Approach to Treatment of Headaches

Course Description

Headache treatment can be extremely overwhelming as headaches involve several different body systems and affect up to 75% of people.
